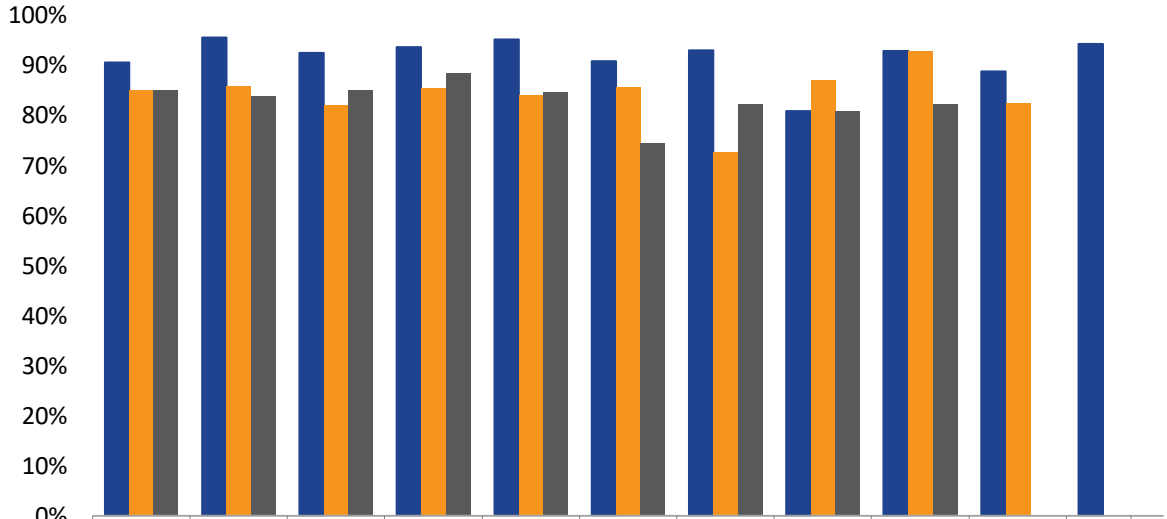

Fall-to-Fall Cohort Retention Rates Entering Cohorts (2012-2022)

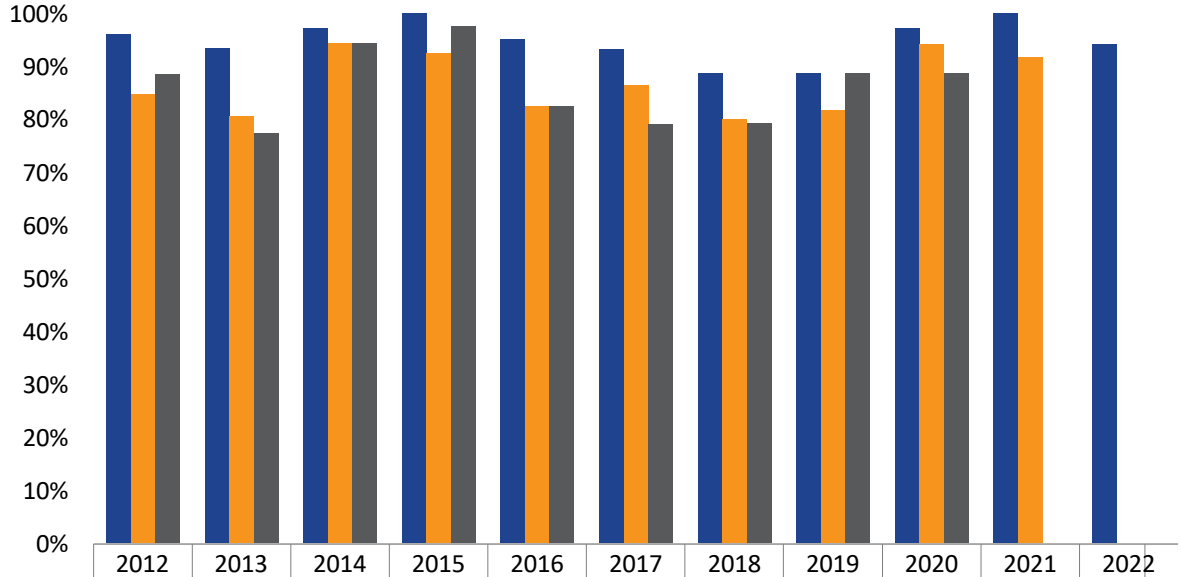

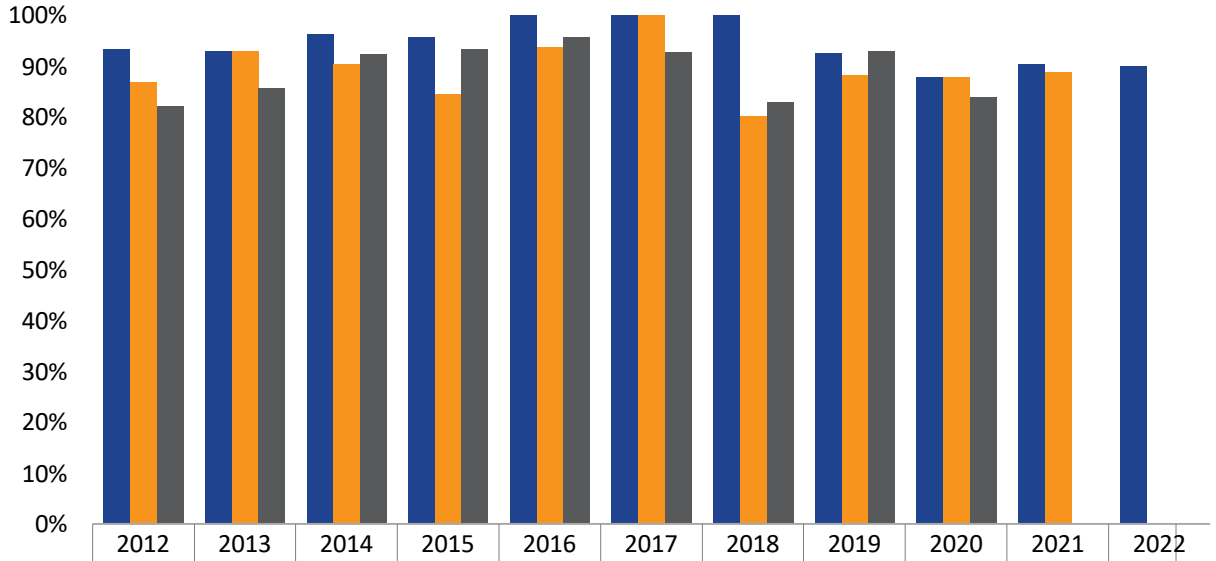
